Why Foundation?



Foundation courses are an increasingly popular way to enter into university undergraduate degree programmes in the UK. A foundation programme offers several benefits for students, such as:

01

Providing students with a strong academic foundation which will help them succeed at university.

02

Developing essential study skills such as critical thinking, research, and analysis.

03

Increasing the chances of being accepted into a desired university programme.

04

Providing a pathway for students who are unsure about their desired career path, allowing them to explore different subjects and areas of interest.

Foundation explained

They are courses designed specifically for international students to help them attain the right level of qualifications and skills they need to succeed at UK university degree level.

Typically available as

- an intensive two or three-term programme of academic subjects, study skills and English language preparation.

01

Designed for international students

International students face unique challenges when they get to UK universities. These courses are specifically designed to address the needs of students from all over the world. They're tailored to students to ensure that they are academically ready and personally confident enough to take on and succeed at an undergraduate course at a UK university.

Fills any gaps in knowledge between high school and university

Get used to university-style teaching

As a graduate of one of these courses you'll have an advantage over students entering higher education straight from school. They are taught using university-style teaching, often on-campus, with lectures, tutorials and seminar-styles classes. This all helps prepare you better for your future university studies.

Time to adjust

Arriving at the place you want to study, two to three years before you begin your full degree programme, gives you plenty of time to settle into everyday life, not just academic life. It means you have time to make friends, soak up those cultural differences and practical things like finding your way around town. It puts you in touch with other students who are experiencing just the same fear and excitement as you, ensuring you're on a firm foundation when you begin your undergraduate course.

A guaranteed university place

Once you complete your course and achieve the required grades, you'll be guaranteed entry into the first year (or second year if after the International Year One) of your chosen undergraduate degree at your chosen university.
