

Why Foundation?



Foundation courses are an increasingly popular way to enter into university undergraduate degree programmes in the UK. A foundation programme offers several benefits for students, such as:

01

Providing students with a strong academic foundation which will help them succeed at university.

02

Developing essential study skills such as critical thinking, research, and analysis.

03

Increasing the chances of being accepted into a desired university programme.

04

Providing a pathway for students who are unsure about their desired career path, allowing them to explore different subjects and areas of interest.

Foundation explained



They are courses designed specifically for international students to help them attain the right level of qualifications and skills they need to succeed at UK university degree level.

- an intensive two or three-term/semester programme of academic subjects, study skills and English language preparation.

01

Designed for international students

International students face unique challenges when they get to UK universities. These courses are specifically designed to address the needs of students from all over the world.
